

## Cane Work

I cast on 12 stitches with a size 6 needle and fingering weight yarn. I also used my sharpest needles.

Design is set up with a 4-stitch and 8 rows repeat. There is 1 setup row. I found it easier if I put a stitch marker between each repeat. After row 1, you will have a 6-stitch per repeat.

Row 1	*yo, k1, yo, k3*. Repeat* *
Set Up Row	You now have 6 stitches in repeat.
Row 2	Knit all even rows.
Row 3	*k3, yo (sl 1, k2tog, pass over) yo*. Repeat**.
Row 5	*yo (sl 1, k2tog, pass over), yo, k3*. Repeat* *.
Row 7	*k3, yo (sl 1, k2tog, pass over), yo. Repeat**.
Row 9	*yo (sl 1, k2tog, pass over), yo, k3*. Repeat* *.
Repeat rows 2-9 for pattern.

### NOTES:

This is a favorite design for the fronts of stockings and is generally made about 3" wide. It may extend from the toe to as high as you desire. If you do use this pattern for socks knitted in the round, knit all the even rows.
