

How to Knit these Swatches

Each swatch gives you the number of repeat stitches and rows needed to knit the swatch. You decide how many repeats you want based on the yarn and needle you use and the size swatch you want.

I'm using left over lace-weight and fingering weight yarn. The original book does give any yarn or needle suggestions. This is a good time to use some of your leftover yarn.



